According to the report, Mumbai Congress MLA Amin Patel (81.43 percent) has done the best job. After him, the work of BJP's Parag Alwani (79.96 percent) is commendable. Shiv Sena's MLA Sunil Prabhu (77.19 percent) holds the third position.

Mumbai : Pragastipustka of MLAs in Mumbai by Praja Foundation (**Praja Foundation**) has been brought out in a survey. 2 year report card of MLAs in Mumbai by Praja Foundation (**Report Card**) presented. This report has been prepared based on the presence of the MLAs in the legislature, the questions raised by them and discussions with the citizens of the constituency. According to this report, Mumbai Congress MLA Amin Patel (**Amin Patel**) (81.43 percent) has done the best job. After him, the work of BJP's Parag Alwani (79.96 percent) is commendable. Shiv Sena's MLA Sunil Prabhu (77.19 percent) holds the third position. In this year's Praja Foundation report, only one MLA scored more than 80 percent.

This survey conducted by Praja Foundation includes only 31 MLAs from Mumbai. MLAs who held ministerial post in Mumbai are not included in this survey. It includes the performances of Varsha Gaikwad of Congress, Aditya Thackeray of Shiv Sena, Nawab Malik of NCP, Aslam Sheikh of Congress, Ramesh Latke of Shiv Sena (deceased).

27 percent increase in MLAs with criminal background

Importantly, a survey conducted by the Praja Foundation has shown a 27 percent increase in MLAs with criminal backgrounds in the last two years. The Thirteenth Legislative Assembly had 15 MLAs with criminal backgrounds in its first two years. In the 14th Legislative Assembly, the number of MLAs with criminal backgrounds in the first two years is 19.
